

The Oneida Community Mansion House was home to nearly 300 people who believed they were building "heaven on earth." The Oneida Community shared all property in common and revolutionized ideas of marriage, family, sex, industry, and the role of women in 19th century America. By the 20th century, the commune evolved to become Oneida Ltd.—the largest silverware manufacturer in the world.

The Mansion House is not your typical historic house. Visitors step back in time to historic rooms from the 19th century and interactive exhibits. Guests can also enjoy an in-depth tour with expert guides who enliven the Mansion House with the stories of the people who lived, worked, and played here for over 160 years.
